LCU MkII Royal Netherlands Marines. Landing craft used in beach landings and (re)supply missions.

The LCU's were commissioned after the RNINavy had acquired its amphibious transportship Hr Ms Rotterdam (L800).

Using the ro-ro method, the LCU's can always disembark vehicles in the right direction on a beach.

The MkII is a LCU MkI lengthened by 9 meters to ease beach landings (less draught) and being able to transport an extra 20 tons of supplies.
